Non-record status One Way WA Metric Clout - 7.5m diameter with 5 zone scoring. Three dozen arrows to be shot with one end of six sighters. The following distances shall be shot and awarded for Recurve, Barebow & Longbow. No Compound bows.

Gentlemen - 165m

Ladies - 125m

Provision will be made for junior distances depending on entries received as per rule 707. We have space for 4 clouts maximum.

Please NOTE: All archers must have received instruction in clout shooting prior to the competition (Archery GB rule 700e) and must sign on the form to confirm this where it says. "Sign here for rule 700 (e)".

If you are not able to receive this instruction please do not sign. At **10:15am** on the day of the shoot there will be a short instruction session and the form can be signed afterwards. If you wish to attend the 10:15am session sign the column on the form **before the day of the shoot** where it says "Sign here for the 10:15am session". Those attending this session will be allowed to include scores in the main shoot.

WAND SHOOTING STARTS AT 1:30 PM*

Our Wands are 6 feet high and 4 inches wide and are made from high density foam to imitate the original peeled willow branch. Six dozen arrows will be shot from 100 yards (Lords), 80 yards (Ladies), and 60 yards (Juniors). One point is scored for each hit and a special 'colour spot' prize is also available – a replica medieval arrow. In the event of a tie the archer who recorded the first hit will be the winner.

Although this is one of the more difficult shoots, it is both relaxed and enjoyable and all Archers are encouraged to add to this atmosphere by wearing medieval costume if they so wish!

All bow types except Compound Bows and Crossbows are welcome. Sighting aids are permitted. No all carbon arrows please. The foam wands are 4" deep and are timber backed. In choosing your arrows for the day, please be aware that the foam will not stop all reaching the backing.

*Timing subject to change depending on the preceding shoot

AWARDS – Best Lord/Lady/Junior in the following classes

1. Traditional Longbow, 2. Any other permitted bow type eg Recurve, AFB etc..

Wand Team Prize – Club teams of 3 made up based on best scores and entries. At least one Longbow archer per team minimum.

All Archers must be members of GNAS.

Refreshments: Bacon Baps will be available before the Clout, and at lunchtime, if ordered by 11am. Tea/coffee and a selection of savouries, cakes and biscuits will be available throughout the day. There is plenty of space for picnics.

Prize giving for both shoots will be after the Wand. Closing date for entries 5th May 2019. Target list will follow.

ENTRY FEE £10.00 if shooting both. If shooting one shoot only entry is £6.
